

## **UniBrass Foundation** **Statement on Gambling**

The UniBrass Foundation offers gambling products in the form of:

- a subscription based Society Lottery, operated by the UniBrass Foundation, and administered by Sterling Lottery Management
- Raffles run from time to time at in person events.

UniBrass believes that lotteries and raffles can deliver social benefit through the money they raise for charities and other good causes. As with any gambling activity, these can be associated with problem gambling (including gambling addictions). The UniBrass Foundation believes that lotteries and raffles are a low-risk gambling product, and promote responsible gambling, defining responsible gambling as:

*“staying in control of how much time and money we spend on gambling. Responsible gambling means not spending more money or time than we can reasonably afford on gambling activities, keeping in mind all our other responsibilities in life.”*

The UniBrass Lottery is administered by Sterling Lotteries Management (“Sterling”), who are licenced and regulated in Great Britain by the Gambling Commission as an External Lottery Manager under account number 3137.
